1. Introduction

The World Conference on Constitutional Justice (WCCJ)

The World Conference on Constitutional Justice unites 119 Constitutional Courts and Councils and Supreme Courts in Africa, the Americas, Asia, Australia/Oceania and Europe. It promotes constitutional justice – understood as constitutional review including human rights case-law – as a key element for democracy, the protection of human rights and the rule of law (Article 1.2 of the Statute).

According to its Statute, the World Conference has three organs, the General Assembly, the Bureau and the Secretariat. The General Assembly is chaired by the Host Court of the Congress. The last host was the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Lithuania. The Presidency of the Bureau is ensured for one year by rotation between the groups. The Presidency of the Bureau is therefore not that of an individual Court but of a group of Courts. Since 21 September 2016, the Presidency of the Bureau is exercised by the Conference of African Constitutional Jurisdictions. It is up to the groups to designate their representative. The Venice Commission acts as the Secretariat of the World Conference. The World Conference pursues its objectives through the organization of regular congresses, by participating in regional conferences and seminars, by sharing experiences and case-law and by offering good services to members on their request (Article 1.2 of the Statute).

The main purpose of the World Conference is to facilitate judicial dialogue between constitutional judges on a global scale. Due to the obligation of judicial restraint, constitutional judges sometimes have little occasion to conduct a constructive dialogue on constitutional principles in their countries. The exchanges that take place between judges from various parts of the world in the World Conference furthers reflection on arguments, which promote the basic goals inherent to national constitutions. Even if these texts often differ substantially, discussion on the underlying constitutional concepts

unites constitutional judges from various parts of the world committed to promoting constitutionality in their own country.

As these judges sometimes find themselves in situations of conflict with other state powers because of decisions they had to hand down based on the Constitution, being part of the World Conference provides them with a forum that not only allows them to exchange information freely with their peers, but where judges from other countries can also offer moral support. This can be important in upholding constitutional principles, which the judges are called upon to defend in their line of work.

The members committed to the principles of the World Conference may see their membership suspended by the General Assembly of the World Conference in case of flagrant violation of these.

16. Health Protocol and PCR

PCR Test

Delegates who will attend the Opening Ceremony are required to do a PCR test.

The PCR test will be held on October 4, 2022. Located at Uluwatu Terrace, Taman Jepun, BNDCC 1, at 07:30 - 18:00 GMT+8. After that operation hour, the test will be done at Ngurah Rai International Airport, Bali

FAQ regarding the interoperability between the Digital COVID Certificates of the European Union and the Republic of Indonesia.

1. I have a European Union Digital COVID Certificate (EUDCC) and I want to travel to Indonesia. Do I need to possess a paper format of EUDCC during check-in at a European airport?

Based on Circular Letter No.19 of COVID-19 Taskforce of the Republic of Indonesia, a Pelaku Perjalanan Luar Negeri (International Traveler) is obliged to have a complete vaccine dosage (two doses or one dose depending on vaccine brand) and show proof through a vaccine certificate format, in paper and digital form.

2. Is it obligatory for the vaccine certificate to include the second dose and booster shot? What if I choose for only one dose of vaccine or not to vaccinate at all?

Based on Circular Letter No.19 of COVID-19 Taskforce of the Republic of Indonesia, a Pelaku Perjalanan Luar Negeri (International Traveller) is obliged to have a complete vaccine dosage (for single dose vaccines and two dosage vaccine) and demonstrate proof through a vaccine certificate format, in paper and digital form. Single dose vaccines are valid for certain types of vaccines. If a Pelaku Perjalanan Luar Negeri (International Traveller) chooses to not vaccinate due to a comorbidity or doctor's recommendation, he/she is obliged to obtain a doctor's letter, letter from a public

hospital or health authority, which state that he/she no longer actively transmits COVID-19; or a COVID-19 recovery certificate from the country where he/she is traveling from.

3. Do I need to install the PeduliLindungi app before I travel to Indonesia?

Based on Circular Letter No.19 of COVID-19 Taskforce of the Republic of Indonesia, a Pelaku Perjalanan Luar Negeri (International Traveler) is obliged to have a complete vaccine dosage (for single dose vaccines and two dosage vaccine) and demonstrate proof through a vaccine certificate format, in paper and digital form. Single dose vaccines are valid for certain types of vaccines.

4. If I am obliged to download PeduliLindungi app and completely fill in the profile section, how is that data processed?

That data is stored in the Pusat Data Nasional (National Data Center), managed by the Indonesian Ministry of Communication and Information Technology, and only used to trace the mitigation and respond to COVID-19 cases within Indonesia.

5. Does PeduliLindungi App have its personal data and information protection policy?

Personal data protection and system security within PeduliLindungi App is a priority concern of the Ministry of Health. All PeduliLindungi app features operate under a data protection and security framework called Data Ownership and Stewardship. Consent is embedded in every data exchange transaction (in addition to metadata and the data itself), for example through the check-in feature in public areas, access to devices, to deleting usage history. These features are presented to respond to the increasingly dynamic needs of the COVID-19 response. The PeduliLindungi app is developed and guided by the global consensus through the 2020 World Health

Organization Joint Statement on Data Protection and Privacy in the COVID-19 Response, an internationally acknowledged reference instrument for practicing data and technology for COVID-19 health protocols.

The Indonesian Ministry of Health has held strategic collaborations with various parties to ensure that the electronic system within the PeduliLindungi app is safe and feasible to use. Together with the Indonesian National Cyber and Crypto Agency, the Indonesian Ministry of Health has implemented a layered security system, namely security for applications, security for infrastructure (including data centres) and security for encrypted data. PeduliLindungi app has gone through a series of technical and legal assessments within the context of registering as an electronic system operator at the Indonesian Ministry of Communication and Information Technology, and data placing at the National Data Center of the Indonesian Ministry of Communication and Information Technology. Thus, PeduliLindungi app is a reliable, safe and responsible electronic system. See the data privacy policy at <https://www.pedulilindungi.id/kebijakan-privasi-data>.

6. Is the PeduliLindungi app server located outside of Indonesian territory? If so, which national jurisdiction is my data located and processed on this server?

The server of the PeduliLindungi app has never been placed outside Indonesia. Since the beginning, the server has been owned by the Indonesian government, located within the National Data Centre of the Indonesian Ministry of Communication and Information.

7. How long will my personal data and information be stored inside the PeduliLindungi app?

Personal data and information sent when registering will be deleted from the application server for at least 5 (five) years after PeduliLindungi stops operating. Submitted data of the users of the

Non-Indonesia vaccine certificate scheme is automatically deleted after successful validation.

8. How do I upload a EUDCC in the PeduliLindungi app? What documents should I prepare when registering for it?

Follow these steps to upload an EU issued covid certificate:

- a. After successful registration, login to PeduliLindungi app
- b. Make sure your profile section (located in the upper left corner) is completed with your full name, identity document number, date of birth, mobile number, active email. Submit. On the front page, open “vaccine and immunisation” menu, choose “COVID-19 Vaccination”, choose “Vaccine Non-Indonesia”
- c. Select “vaccination status checking” to continue
- d. If you have never submitted data before, fill in your email and select the number of vaccinations you want to input. Make sure to upload your appropriate identity document (Indonesian citizens with KTP/KK, Foreigners with passport number).
- e. Enter your vaccination data correctly. Make sure to upload the right number of documents that matches the number of dosages you took.
- f. Confirm the data and you will see a YELLOW STATUS (“Menunggu Persetujuan/Pending Approval”) as proof of submission.
- g. Wait for the verification process within 3-5 working days.

9. Is an Indonesian cellular number required to register on the PeduliLindungi App? If not, can I register my European cellular number?

No. PeduliLindungi accommodates registration using email and cellular numbers from countries outside Indonesia. We recommend ensuring that your non-Indonesia cellular number is active on whatsapp for the ease of sending a one time password when

verifying account registration or logging into PeduliLindungi. If you do not have Whatsapp, registration can be done through email.

10. Upon arrival at an Indonesian airport, is there an ease of verification process through a special route for EUDCC holders?

No. We recommend you ascertain your verification through the PeduliLindungi app prior to departure for your own convenience. Post departure verification at an Indonesian airport will be done through Port Health Officers for all international travellers.

11. While in Indonesia, am I required to scan the (PeduliLindungi COVID-19) QR Code when entering public places?

Yes. The QR Code Scan policy is aimed for the common good, with the objective of understanding the number of persons in a public area and ascertaining whether a person who enters these places has been vaccinated and poses no (COVID-19) risk. High risk individuals will be advised to get vaccinated immediately and may be subject to carry with a doctor's letter. This policy is in accordance with the Instructions of the Indonesian Minister of Home Affairs (currently the Instruction of Minister of Home Affairs No. 35/2022 (Enforcement of Restrictions Towards Community Activities During COVID-19) and Instruction No. 34/2022 (Enforcement of Level 1-2 Restrictions towards community activities and Optimalization of COVID-19 Management Posts at Villages and Sub-Districts to Control the Spread of COVID-19 in Sumatera, Nusa Tenggara, Kalimantan, Sulawesi, Maluku and Papua).

12. Is it therefore possible to conduct position tracking? If so, how is this data used for tracking, especially in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic?

PeduliLindungi does not conduct position tracking. As described, check-in data sent to the app (through QR code) by way of scanning

from public places are only used to ensure individuals traveling to public places are those who have been vaccinated and are not at risk. Individuals who are known to be in close contact with positive or high-risk patients when trying to enter public places will be given a notification for vaccination and/or performing a COVID-19 antigen/PCR test.

- 13. In member countries of the European Union, EU DCC holders do not scan QR codes prior to entering a public place, I simply scan my vaccine certificate with a separate app verifier carried out by the owner/employee of said public place. Can I do the same process in Indonesia? (Is there a special place to scan foreign vaccine certificates)**

Yes, currently the EU vaccine verifier is available in the PeduliLindungi application so that when EU citizens enter a public place, the owner/employee of the public place can verify the certificate you have or carry.

- 14. Is the EU DCC verifier and infrastructure readily available in public facilities, including tourist attractions?**

Since barcode scans of EU vaccine certificates are already embedded within the PeduliLindungi app, no additional infrastructure is placed in tourist attractions or public places. Owners/employees of public places can directly scan the EU DCC barcode from their respective devices.

- 15. Following the implementation of the interoperability (between COVID-19 vaccine systems of Indonesia and the EU), are EU member states embassies and consulates required to verify their citizens?**

No. Interoperability (across systems and platforms) are made feasible through the PeduliLindungi app, by way of EU DCC

barcode scanning.

EU DCC is already used by 27-member states and 40 other countries who have established an interoperability cooperation with the EU. This cooperation forged with Indonesia has supported the ease of cross-country travel of EU citizens and Indonesians alike, while complying with its respective issues of sovereignty and health protocols.

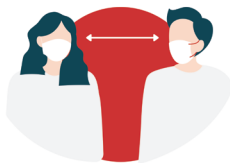
